# Order of Honour

## Nomination Form

The Order of Honour is a society of Professional Engineers Ontario (PEO). Its purpose is to recognize and honour those professional engineers and others who have rendered outstanding service to the engineering profession in Ontario, primarily through PEO.

Inclusion in the Order may be awarded by PEO Council to PEO members who have served the profession diligently for many years and/or have made a substantial contribution to the operation of the profession or improvement in its status. Such service will primarily be rendered through participation in PEO affairs. Service performed in other engineering organizations or agencies may be considered but only as complementary to PEO service. Provision is made in the order's Regulations to recognize service rendered by non-members of PEO. Nominations are considered by PEO's Awards Committee, which will assess the nominations and make its recommendations to PEO Council. The committee may also conduct its own research and make independent selections and recommendations for inclusion in the order. All nominations received will be considered on an equal basis.

All five nominators must be professional engineers and members of Professional Engineers Ontario. Nominators should supply complete detail on their nominee. Individual statements from each nominator on the reasons the candidate should be considered for this award must accompany the nomination.

Induction of worthy members into the Order of Honour is a competitive process. Therefore, nominators' letters should highlight not only the years of service, but also the substantial contribution and impact candidates have made on the engineering profession. Inclusion in the Order is granted in one of three levels: Member, Officer or Companion. Nominations should not make any recommendations as to the level but should include sufficient information to enable the committee to make its recommendation. Nominations may be made at any time, but are considered annually.

### *Please read the following carefully*

1. Please note that induction into the Order of Honour is a competitive process. No more than 13 people are inducted annually, with no more than two Companions and four Officers and the remainder being Members. Therefore, nomination packages need to highlight the significance and impact of the nominee's contributions to the engineering profession.
2. List all PEO service activities and include dates of such service. Include the names of committees served or special functions performed on behalf of PEO.
3. If the nomination is being made for a specific contribution or contributions, supply full details of the activity or activities and why it or they should be recognized.
4. Give details of service rendered through other engineering bodies and indicate how this has contributed to the operation of the profession or improvement in its status.

5. Individual statements from each nominator on why the nominee should be considered for this award must accompany the nomination. Please note that the nomination letters are the most significant component of the nomination packages and should be written by those who can substantiate the significance of the nominee's contributions. 6. Materials that support the nomination, such as clippings, testimonials, or letters of support, may be included.
7. Nomination packages **should not exceed 15 pages**, excluding the nomination form. Any pages beyond 15 will not be considered in the selection process.
8. Deadline for receipt of nominations is **4:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time** on the **second Friday in October**. Nominations submitted after the deadline will not be considered for that year's awards program, but may be considered at the discretion of the committee before the deadline for the following year's program. To increase your chances of success, you are encouraged to update the package.
