



Additional Requirements – Ontario Labour Mobility Act

The Ontario Labour Mobility Act, 2009, section 11 specifies the regulator's Duty to Publish.

Every Ontario regulatory authority shall publish, on a publicly accessible website maintained by the regulatory authority, every requirement that the regulatory authority imposes, as a condition of certification in a regulated occupation, on applicants who are already certified in the same occupation by an out-of-province regulatory authority.

Certain applicants will undergo additional assessments by the Registrar and through referral for determinations by the Academic Requirements Committee and/or Experience Requirements Committee, as a condition of being licensed in Ontario as follows:

1. Note: Effective November 19, 2010 all Additional Requirements regarding professional engineers in good standing in any Canadian jurisdiction that were previously listed in the December 9, 2009 Notice have been suspended. P.Eng. applicants in good standing who applied between December 9, 2009 and November 18, 2010 are no longer subject to the "Additional Requirements".
2. The application of a holder of a temporary licence in another Canadian jurisdiction applying for the issuance of a temporary licence will be assessed by PEO to ensure that the applicant meets all the requirements prescribed by Ontario Regulation 941 made under the *Professional Engineers Act* for the issuance of a temporary licence.
3. The application of a holder of a limited licence in another Canadian jurisdiction applying for the issuance of a limited licence will be assessed by PEO to ensure that the applicant meets all the requirements prescribed by Ontario Regulation 941 made under the *Professional Engineers Act* for the issuance of a limited licence.
4. The application of a holder of a provisional licence in another Canadian jurisdiction applying for the issuance of a provisional licence will be assessed by PEO to ensure that the applicant meets all the requirements prescribed by Ontario Regulation 941 made under the *Professional Engineers Act* for the issuance of a provisional licence.
