



## *Call for volunteers 2012*

### **Experienced Practitioners Task Force (EPTF)**

PEO Council has approved the appointment of a new task force – Experienced Practitioners Task Force (EPTF). As per Council’s direction, the purpose of the task force is to develop:

- i. more concise definitions of incompetence, unprofessional conduct, and conduct unbecoming a professional;
- ii. a process for sifting complaints and defining the requirements of those suitable for resolution by a simple peer review, without lawyers.
- iii. a simple peer review process that is fair and economical, and that would be a prerequisite of such complaints before they enter the more formal adversarial area of complaints and discipline.

#### Time commitment:

Anticipated time for final report is 1 year based on 3 face-to-face meetings and e-correspondence as required.

#### The initial key criteria for consideration include:

- Must have 20 or more years of experience in the consulting business.
- Be familiar with complaints and discipline process.

All candidates must be licensed professional engineers in good standing with the Association.
