**Action: George** to revise document to reflect this discussion and circulate for comment. **Tyson** to revise the Scope of Practice based on the feedback received from stakeholders to date. **Jordan** to add HRSDC and community colleges (e.g. computer science/IT) as a CIE stakeholder
