8. <u>Procedural and Related Matter(s)</u>

8.1 <u>LEL Implementation Update</u>

David Kiguel participated in the LEL teleconference. It was noted that the teleconference was named "training" which included ARC and ERC members as well as the new ERC coordinators for limited licence. The purpose of the training was to perform "dry runs" of going through existing Limited Licence holders who had applied using the old regulations.

Lawrence Fogwill suggested taking the question of preparing the ARC syllabi questions to the joint relations subcommittee working group.

Judith Dimitriu discussed 2 files regarding Limited Licence for Faculty Members. The applicants have been advised to apply for a Limited Licence for Faculty instead of a full P. Eng licence because they don't have the engineering experience. Moody Farag noted that comments should be made on the file for the applicant to further apply for a full P. Eng licence.

8.2 Licensing Committee Update

Bob Dony met with the Chair of CODE about the ongoing faculty issue. A guidance document that was presented at the June 22 meeting of CODE detailing the requirements for licensure was unanimously passed by the deans.

8.3 Red Book Subcommittee

Barna Szabados noted that a time limit cannot be included with a re-application that has a history of failure.
