1. Call to Order

Darla Campbell called the meeting to order at 4:37pm.

2. Approval of Agenda and Minutes

3. Peer Review of GLP Audit Consultant report

- 2. Are there recommendations that we do not agree with?
- 3. Are there elements the GLC does not agree with or have been missed?

Jeannette Chau provided an update on what was happening with the Repeal of the Industrial Exception. The Burden Reduction Act has been presented for second reading and is being debated in the House. It is part of an omnibus bill and the debate could take awhile as other portions of the Act are being debated. We are monitoring.
