On December 6, 1989, the largest mass shooting in Canadian history occurred at École Polytechnique in Montreal killing 14 women, most of which were engineering students. PEO President **Nancy Hill**, P.Eng., (above) sat on a panel to discuss the impact this had on the engineering community. Other guests on the segment included: **Nathalie Provost**, who survived the attack and is now a Regional Director with the Quebec Government's Ministry of Sustainable Development, Environment and Fight Against Climate Change, **Laura Conquergood**, P.Eng., Vice President of Operations at Baylis Medical, and **Shivani Nathoo**, EIT, Smart Grid and Asset Management Engineering Intern for Hatch Limited. Ms. Hill said "As a regulator, I think it is important for PEO to not forget this as a key time in our history." She also spoke about PEO's 30 by 30 Initiative, whose goal is to have 30% of newly licenced engineers be female by the year 2030. Currently, less than 20% of new licensees are female.
