TWO NEW LIBERAL MPPS ELECTED TO THE LEGISLATURE

(OTTAWA) — Two new Liberal MPPs were elected in by-elections to the Legislature on February 27.

Stephen Blais, a former Ottawa city councillor and school board trustee, was elected for Ottawa-Orléans. **Lucille Collard**, a lawyer and longtime school board trustee, was elected for Ottawa-Vanier.

The by-elections were the result of resignations by **Nathalie Des Rosiers** in Ottawa-Vanier and **Marie-France Lalonde** in Ottawa-Orléans.

The victories for MPPs Blais and Collard bring the total number of seats for the Liberal Party at Queen's Park to eight.
