**Nominations must remain confidential to the nominee** and may be submitted anytime during the year. Nominations submitted after the deadline may be considered for the following year's program at the request of the lead nominator. **The nomination deadline is 4:00 pm EST on the last Wednesday in February each year.**

This section should include areas such as service to society and the community beyond the nominee’s regular employment – volunteer work, including service clubs and charitable organizations; participation in commissions, boards, task groups, etc.; participation in governance (municipal, provincial, federal) as an elected or appointed official; improvement of the physical and/or social environment through engineering and other works. **Maximum 200 words. (5 points)**

**IV. PROVIDE AN OVERALL SUMMARY OF IMPACT**

**Maximum 250 words.**

**SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS**

**Resume** - Please submit a concise copy of the nominee’s resume/CV of no more than three pages. If it exceeds the limit, only the first three pages will be considered.

**Letters of Support** – Please submit three letters of support, one from the Nominator and two additional letters from other P.Eng. Referees. Each letter should emphasize different aspects of the nominee’s achievements and impact to the engineering profession. More letters of support can be included (also from non-P.Eng.s.) as long as the Nomination Package doesn’t exceed 20 pages (excluding the Nomination Form).
