Meanwhile:

1. This is a time wasting, expensive, out-dated, so called professional development programme based on PD hours, that has never been measured as to benefits, that pretends to improve competency.

2. **There will be a fee increase** to mark this passage into law. When asked to explain the need for the last fee increase of 20% across the board, the President said, because there had not been an increase in 10 years. There was a budget surplus of almost \$3 Million for 2019 and we had reserves of \$15 million, plus our building. Fees should be based on the needs of regulatory requirements and subject to member approval.
