Mike Schreiner, MPP (Guelph) was first elected to the Ontario Legislature in 2018. He has served as the leader of the Green Party since 2009 and is the first and only Green Party member elected to the Legislature.

Prior to being elected, MPP Schreiner was an entrepreneur and operated small food-related businesses. He founded multiple initiatives including Local Food Plus, WOW Foods and EarthDance Organics.

He is a regular participant in PEO events and previously was a guest speaker at the 2020 PEO Government Relations Conference.

SOL MAMAKWA, MPP

Sol Mamakwa, MPP (Kiiwetinoong) was first elected to the Ontario Legislature in 2018.

He currently serves as the NDP Critic for Indigenous and Treaty Relations.

Prior to being elected, he served as Co-chair of the Sioux Lookout Meno Ya Win Health Centre's Board of Directors.

He has also been involved with the Sioux Lookout First Nation Health Authority, Sioux Lookout Physicians Regional Services, and the Northern Ontario School of Medicine.
