FINANCE MINISTER RELEASES FALL ECONOMIC STATEMENT

The province's Fall Economic Statement titled *2021 Ontario Economic Outlook and Fiscal Review: Build Ontario* was released by Finance Minister **Peter Bethlenfalvy**, MPP (Pickering-Uxbridge) on November 4.

The Government is projecting a deficit this fiscal year of \$21.5 billion. It is less than the \$33.1 billion projection from the budget, due to high tax revenues and strong economic growth.

Here is an excerpt from the statement: "the province's recovery will be driven by sustained economic growth that will lead to job creation and greater prosperity. While the government can create the conditions for growth, it will ultimately be the people of Ontario who step forward to unleash the province's full potential."

Given the uncertainty as the province continues to deal with the COVID-19 pandemic, the Ministry of Finance has developed faster growth and slower growth scenarios to prepare the public for the different paths to economic recovery.

A memorial service for Ontario's 18th Premier **William Davis** was held at Roy Thomson Hall on November 4. He passed away in August.

Over 400 prominent politicians and residents attended including former Premiers **Dalton McGuinty**, **Ernie Eves**, **Mike Harris**, and **David Peterson** as well as former Prime Minister **Brian Mulroney**. Speakers included Prime Minister **Justin Trudeau** and Premier **Doug Ford**, MPP (Etobicoke North). TVO's **Steve Paikin**, who is a former winner of the PEO President's Award, moderated the event.

Also attending were former PEO Willowdale Thornhill Chapter Chair **Nanda Lwin**, P.Eng. and PEO Government Relations Consultant **Howard Brown**.

During Mr. Davis' time as Premier from 1971 to 1985, he played a role in amending the *Professional Engineers Act*, which made significant changes to the regulation of the practice of engineering.

Mr. Lwin and Mr. Brown had a chance to speak to a number of dignitaries afterwards including former Premier McGuinty, former Minister of Colleges and Universities **Reza Moridi**, and **David Lindsay** who served as Deputy Minister for a variety of portfolios including Energy and Infrastructure, Northern Development, Mines, and Forestry, and Natural Resources.

EIGHT MPPS ANNOUNCE THEY WILL NOT SEEK RE-ELECTION



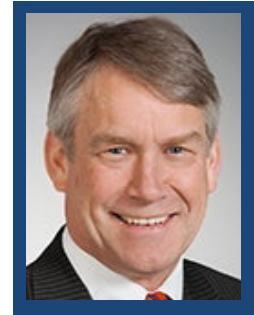

- **Rick Nicholls**, MPP (Chatham-Kent-Leamington), former Deputy Speaker
- **Lindsey Park**, MPP (Durham), former Parliamentary Assistant to the Attorney General
- **Jim Wilson**, MPP (Simcoe-Grey), former Minister of various portfolios
- **Kathleen Wynne**, MPP (Don Valley West), former Premier

Andrea Horwath, MPP (NDP - Hamilton Centre) was first elected to the Ontario Legislature in 2004. She became Leader of the New Democratic Party in 2007. She is the NDP Critic for Intergovernmental Affairs.

Prior to being elected, MPP Horwath served on Hamilton City Council for three terms. MPP Horwath holds a degree in Labour Studies from McMaster University. She has been an active participant in PEO events and was a guest speaker at the PEO annual Government Relations Conferences in 2016, 2018, and 2020.

Jeremy Roberts (PC - Ottawa West—Nepean) was first elected to the Ontario Legislature in 2018. He is the Parliamentary Assistant to the Minister of Children, Community and Social Services. Prior to being elected, MPP Roberts served as an advisor to former federal Ministers **Jim Flaherty**, **Joe Oliver**, and **Rona Ambrose**.

He holds a degree in Political Science from Carleton University and a Master of Public Policy from the University of Oxford. He shared remarks for PEO Ottawa Chapter's Annual General Meeting in February.

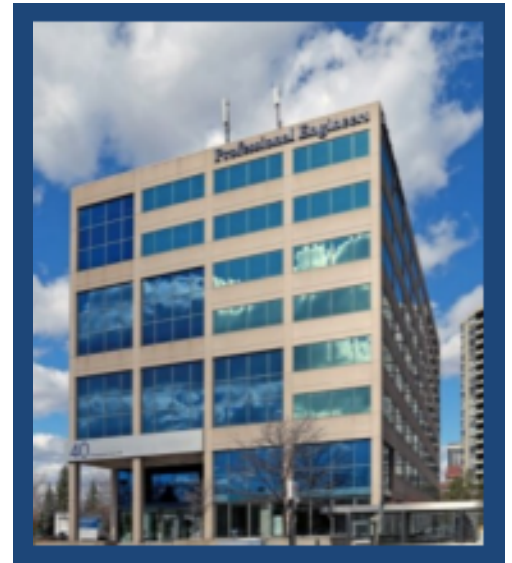
