Hon. **Parm Gill**, MPP (PC - Milton) was first elected to the Ontario Legislature in 2018.

He was appointed as the Minister of Citizenship and Multiculturalism in June 2021. He previously served as the Parliamentary Assistant to the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing.

Minister Gill also served as the Member of Parliament for the riding of Brampton-Springdale from 2011 to 2015.

During his time as MP, he served as Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Veteran Affairs, and later, the Minister of International Trade. Prior to being elected, he was involved in his family businesses in the manufacturing and hospitality industries. He holds a Master of Business Administration degree from Western University.

Minister Gill has been a regular participant in PEO Oakville Chapter activities.

DOLY BEGUM, MPP

Doly Begum, MPP (Scarborough Southwest) was first elected to the Ontario Legislature in 2018.

She is the NDP Critic for Citizenship, Foreign Credentials and Immigration Services.

Prior to being elected, she was Co-Chair of the Scarborough Health Coalition, Vice-Chair of Warden Woods Community Centre, and a research analyst at the Society of Energy Professionals.


