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Daniel's stance on immediate key PEO issues:

- ✓ Relevant training can be valuable to members, but mandatory Continuing Professional Development (CPD) hours and PEAK for ALL members is not effective in protecting the public.
- ✓ PEO Act Exemptions (i.e. practicing without a license) and emerging new technology/innovation still requires oversight.
- ✓ Protect use of Engineer title.
- ✓ Support PEO chapters in continuing to service and engage members.
- ✓ Enhance volunteer recognition program.

- ✓ Explore alternative membership options.
- Ally with employers, Universities, and other organizations to promote value of P.Eng. licensing and PEO/OPSE membership.
