BARRIE - New PEO GLP rep, **Rob Martinko**, P.Eng., held a virtual meeting with his MPP, **Andrea Khanjin**, (Barrie-Innisfil) on July 27. Mr. Martinko introduced himself to MPP Khanjin as the PEO GLP rep for her riding and explained to her how PEO is working to comply with amendments the government made to the *Fair Access to Regulated Professions and Compulsory Trades Act* (FARPACTA) and implement mandatory continuing professional development (CPD) in January 2023.

MPP Khanjin is also the Deputy Government House Leader, Deputy Government Whip and Parliamentary Assistant to the Minister of Intergovernmental Affairs.

Afterward, MPP Khanjin tweeted her thanks to Mr. Martinko and Mr. Brown, and said, "It was great learning about PEO and I'm very excited to continue working with all of you!"

MPP Khanjin has been supportive of PEO in the past, including attending the PEO Simcoe-Muskoka Chapter Annual General Meeting and Licence Certificate Ceremony in 2019 in Barrie.

It is important for GLP reps to build and maintain relationships with their elected officials, as it provides MPPs with knowledge on PEO's mandate as the regulator of the profession in the public interest.

PEO KINGSTON CHAPTER GLP CHAIR SPEAKS WITH NEW MPP AT COMMUNITY EVENT



LAURA SMITH, MPP

Laura Smith represents the Progressive Conservative Party. She is the Parliamentary Assistant to the Minister of Tourism, Culture and Sport.

Prior to her election to the Legislature, MPP Smith worked in the legal profession for many years and owned a litigation support company.

She was also a former vice president of a co-operative nursery school in her community as well as a Director with the Thornhill Thunder Soccer Club.

MPP Smith studied political science at York University and legal administration at Seneca College.

TED HSU, MPP

Ted Hsu is a member of the Liberal Party. He is the party critic for Energy; Mines; Natural Resources and Forestry; and Citizenship and Multiculturalism.

Prior to his election to the Legislature, MPP Hsu worked as Executive Director at SWITCH, a local sustainable energy association. He also previously worked in the finance industry and conducted academic research in physics.

In 2011, he was elected MP for Kingston and the Islands. He chose not to seek re-election in 2015 to spend more time with his young family. During his time as an MP, he served as his part

He earned his Bachelor's degree in physics at Queen's University and completed his PhD in physics at Princeton University. MPP Hsu's father was a chemical engineering professor at Queen's University.
