PEO ANNOUNCES NEW CEO APPOINTMENT



Jennifer Quaglietta, P.Eng., will become the new PEO CEO/Registrar on January 9, 2023.

On November 17, PEO Council announced the appointment of their new CEO/Registrar **Jennifer Quaglietta**, P.Eng., effective January 9, 2023.

Ms. Quaglietta previously served as the Vice President of Performance Excellence and Information Services at Healthcare Insurance Reciprocal of Canada and on the Board of Trustees at Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital.

She holds a Master of Business Administration program from the Rotman School of Management and the University of Toronto's Bachelor of Applied Science and Engineering program.

She will be responsible for PEO's administration of the *Professional Engineers Act*. Under the authority of the act, PEO licenses professional engineers, and sets standards for and regulates engineering so that the public interest is served and protected. She will succeed **Johnny Zuccon**, P.Eng., FEC, who announced his intention to retire in March 2022.

"On behalf of our Council, I'm thrilled to welcome Jennifer to our organization," said PEO President **Nick Colucci**, P.Eng. "Jennifer has achieved extensive success and leadership in activities supporting public protection, policy and strategy, operations, and quality improvement. RICK BYERS, MPP

Rick Byers represents the Progressive Conservative Party. He is the Parliamentary Assistant to the Minister of Finance. He was first elected in the June 2022 election.

Early in his career Mr. Byers served as Special Assistant in Tax Policy for former Minister of Finance, **Michael Wilson**. Mr.Byers also served as the Vice-Chair of the South East Grey Community Health Centre and as Treasurer of the Royal Canadian Legion Branch 333.

MPP Byers was a Chartered Accountant with Thorne Riddell (now KPMG), and the Managing Director of Government Investment Banking at Burns Fry/BMO Capital Markets.

JENNIFER (JENNIE) STEVENS, MPP

Jennifer (Jennie) Stevens is a member of the New Democratic Party as the critic for Veterans, Legions and Military Affairs, Sport, and Tourism. She is the first woman to hold the seat for the city of St. Catharines.

Prior to MPP Stevens' election in 2018, she was a city councillor for Merritton Ward for 15 years. She has a background in the not-for profit sector, having served on the St. Catharines Budget Committee, the Merritton Athletic Association, and the board of the Niagara Folk Arts Multicultural Centre.

On her website, it says that she strongly advocates for affordable housing, tenant rights and mental health and addiction.
