DAVENPORT MPP CONFIRMED AS NEW NDP LEADER

Marit Stiles, MPP (Davenport) has been confirmed as the new leader of the New Democratic Party for Ontario. The decision was formalized at a party meeting on February 4, and was attended by more than 300 party supporters.

MPP Stiles was first elected in 2018, and was the Education Critic. She is also the former president of the New Democratic Party of Canada. **Peter Tabuns**, MPP (Toronto-Danforth), served as interim leader since June 2022, after **Andrea Horwath** stepped down after 13 years as leader. The NDP caucus has been very supportive of PEO's legislative initiatives.

PEO and *GLP Weekly Times* both congratulate MPP Stiles on the election, and look forward to continuing working with her.

ONTARIO OUTLINES HEALTH CARE SYSTEM PLAN

Deputy Premier and Health Minister **Sylvia Jones**, MPP (Dufferin- Caledon) was guest speaker at the Empire Club of Canada on February 7.

She addressed the province's plan for better connected care, reduced wait times in hospitals, and improvements in patient experience. To hear the speech and question period following, see <u>here</u>.

On the same day, Premier **Doug Ford**, MPP (Etobicoke North) met with Prime Minister **Justin Trudeau**, MP (Papineau) and other first Ministers to review new funding for healthcare.

Regulators from across the province were participants at the Empire Club event, which was attended by over 300 stakeholders including PEO *GLP Weekly Times*.

Minister Jones met with PEO Brampton Chapter representatives in January 2022 in an online meeting to update her on PEO initiatives.

Minister Jones was the first MPP to raise concerns regarding the repeal of the industrial exception from the *Professional Engineers Act*. PEO representatives have worked hard to build a rapport with Minister Jones as an important spokesperson on regulatory issues.

Jess Dixon, MPP is Parliamentary Assistant to the Minister of Energy and a former Crown Attorney in Kitchener. She was first elected in the June 2022 Ontario Election.

MPP Dixon graduated from the University of Ottawa's law program in 2013. After serving as a crown attorney, she grew frustrated with issues in the judicial system pertaining to how it manages the 'mentally ill, homeless, and addicted' leading to her eventual bid for election.

FRANCE GÉLINAS, MPP (NICKEL BELT)

France Gélinas, MPP is the NDP's current critic for Health and Long-Term Care, and Francophone Affairs.

She was first elected in 2007, and has been re-elected four times.

MPP Gélinas is the executive director of the Community Health Centre of Sudbury, and served as the President of the Francophone Reference Group of the Northern Ontario School of Medicine.

She regularly participates in PEO events in her riding and at Queen's Park.
