# NDP CANDIDATE WINS FORMER LEADER'S SEAT WITH LANDSLIDE VICTORY

HAMILTON - Political newcomer **Sarah Jama** won the March 16th Hamilton Centre by-election for the New Democratic Party. Ms. Jama captured 54.3 per cent of the vote — a margin of more than 6,000 ballots. There was only a 22 per cent turnout for the by-elecetion.

Ms. Jama is the co-founder and Executive Director of the Disability Justice Network of Ontario.

NDP Leader **Marit Stiles**, MPP (Davenport) was also pleased with the election results. The seat was long held by former leader **Andrea Horwath**, who was elected Mayor of Hamilton last October. She served as the MPP for Hamilton Centre from 2007 to 2022.

The NDP Opposition has regularly supported PEO's legislative efforts, and many of their MPPs regularly participate in chapter activities.

It is important for PEO chapters to reach out to all MPPs, and bring them up to date on PEO's work as the regulator of the profession of public interest.

In his video, MPP Glover made references to PEO's mandatory continuing professional development program and PEO's work to comply with recent amendments to the Fair Access to Regulated Professions and Compulsory Trades Act.

MPP Glover also addressed his recent discussion with PEO East Toronto Chapter GLP Chair **Omid Sadeghi**, EIT about the work that PEO does.

"We have COVID heroes, we have healthcare heroes, we have people who are helping seniors or helping vulnerable people. Engineers, your role is to solve problems. You are solving all kinds of problems that help people in the community. So next year, in January, we're going to be asking for nominations for our Community Service Awards. Please nominate your colleagues or one of your colleagues who's done some work or helped solve a problem that is helping people in the community.

"We'd really like to acknowledge the work that they are doing, and I want to acknowledge the work that all, all of you, the engineers of Ontario, are doing in helping to build this province."

# FORMER TRANSPORTATION MINISTER WINS PRESIDENCY OF ONTARIO LIBERAL PARTY

HAMILTON - Former MPP **Kathryn McGarry** was elected as President of the Ontario Liberal Party at their annual meeting on March 2 at the Hamilton Convention Centre.

Ms. McGarry previously served as both Minister of Transportation and Minister of Natural Resources and Forestry under former Premier **Kathleen Wynne**, MPP (Don Valley West). She also served as the MPP for Cambridge from 2014 to 2018, and as Cambridge Mayor from 2018 to 2022.

During her time at Queen's Park, Ms. McGarry regularly participated in PEO events, both with the Grand River Chapter and at the Legislature.

Ontario Liberals have not yet set a date for the election of a new leader. **John Fraser**, MPP (Ottawa-South) continues to serve as interim leader.

Mr. Fraser has regularly met with PEO's Ottawa chapter since his election in 2013.



Todd Smith, MPP was first elected to the Ontario Legislature in 2011 and served the Prince Edward-Hastings riding for seven years.

In June 2018, MPP Smith was re-elected as part of the Progressive Conservative majority government. He currently serves as the PC's Minister of Energy.

A graduate of Loyalist College, MPP Smith had a 16-year career in radio news broadcasting, and was the news director of Quinte Broadcasting before taking office.

### JEFF BURCH, MPP (NIAGARA CENTRE)

Jeff Burch, MPP was first elected to the Ontario Legislature in 2018, and currently serves as the NDP's Caucus Chair and the Official Opposition critic for Municipal Affairs.

He obtained a bachelor's in Philosophy from Brock University, and previously served as a former union leader, CUPE member, and United Steelworker local president.

MPP Burch has worked in the Niagara region as a union representative, City Councillor and Executive Director in the non-profit sector.
