

MISSISSAUGA MAYOR DECLARES FOR ONTARIO LIBERAL LEADERSHIP

MISSISSAUGA — Mississauga Mayor Bonnie Crombie has officially registered to run for the leadership of the Ontario Liberal Party. Mayor Crombie registered and kicked off her campaign on June 12 at a rally in Mississauga, attended by more than 350 people.

She has been endorsed by **Stephanie Bowman**, MPP (Don Valley West), who was planning to run as a candidate herself. MPP Bowman and Mayor Crombie are regular participants in PEO Chapter events. Mayor Crombie filed her nomination papers on June 12, making her the fourth formal candidate in the race to lead the former governing party in Ontario, alongside Liberal MPs **Nate Erskine-Smith** (Beaches-East York), **Yasir Naqvi** (Ottawa Centre) and Liberal MPP **Ted Hsu** (Kingston and the Islands).

The selection of the next leader by the Liberals will be conducted through a ranked ballot vote scheduled for November 25 and 26. The party intends to disclose the results on a round-by-round basis on December 2, the weekend following the vote.
