
The event focused on building community understanding of the different responsibilities of the three levels of government.

Solicitor General **Michael Kerzner**, MPP (York Centre), attended an online town hall meeting on April 17 with PEO LGA Councillor **Paul Mandel** and PEO Government Relations Consultant **Howard Brown**.

Councillor Mandel said that "as a Lieutenant Governor Appointed Councillor, and the only Chartered Professional Accountant on Council, I always find any interaction with a Minister or MPP very helpful."

These opportunities are utilized by Councillor Mandel to further strengthen relationships between government and PEO. He previously attended a Toronto community event in June with a number of MPPs.


This will provide an opportunity for the local PEO GLP Chapter Rep to initiate a meeting with the Solicitor General.
