GOVERNMENT APPOINTS FORMER TOWN ENGINEERING DIRECTOR AS PEO COUNCILLOR

The Ontario government has selected **Rachel Prudhomme**, P.Eng., to serve as a Lieutenant Governor Appointee for a three-year term on PEO Council. She is one of eight LGA appointees and is the only woman.

Prior to working as the Director of Engineering for the Town of Newmarket from 2013 to 2024, she was the Manager of Special Projects for the City of Markham. She was also the President of MAG Engineering and Constructors International Ltd.

Ms. Prudhomme holds both a Bachelor of Engineering and a Master of Science in Applied Physics (Engineering Geophysics) from Laurentian University. She also has a Graduate diploma in Public Administration and Local Municipal Government from Western University.
