<b>Position Type</b>	Committee
<b>Position Description</b>	<p>This committee's mandate is to coordinate, manage, promote and monitor PEO's Order of Honour (OOH) volunteer recognition program, including the nomination and selection processes. The committee's role supports achievement of the object of the <i>Professional Engineers Act</i> to "Promote awareness of the Profession's contribution to society and the role of the association."</p> <p>Currently, there are nine members on the committee. Most members are past recipients of the Order of Honour and external awards in engineering. The committee is looking for one or two new members to join in 2025, and one new member in 2026, following the committee succession planning.</p>
<b>Duration of Position</b>	Committee members are appointed for a one-year term, from January to December, and the expected commitment is a minimum of three years. Committee members may be re-appointed but shall retire from the committee after 10 years of cumulative committee service.

<b>Duties and Responsibilities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Encourage and, where necessary, assist professional engineers to nominate and celebrate deserving peers for recognition through PEO's OOH program.</li> <li>Promote the OOH program through representation at committee and chapter events.</li> <li>Review and make recommendations on OOH recipients.</li> <li>Participate in OOH ceremonies.</li> <li>Review and make recommendations for appropriate recognition through the OOH program.</li> <li>Monitor and review past OOH recipients to identify PEO volunteers deserving further recognition through upgrades.</li> </ul>

<b>General Information</b>	<p>The committee meets three to four (3-4) times during the year (typically on Friday, 10 am – 12 pm) and has one (1) OOH ceremony event.
