Hallam Observatory Tour II

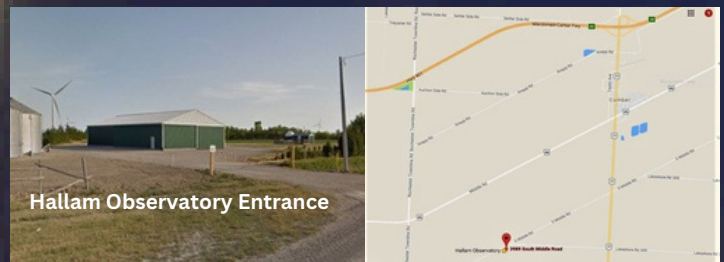
Operated by The Royal Astronomical Society of Canada

Tour Details:

- View the universe and distant stars through a 14" Telescope at the Hallam Observatory.
- Learn about other planets, nebulae, globular clusters and more!
- Tour will begin shortly after civil twilight ends (9:30pm). Please arrive between 9:00 to 9:30pm
- Please Park against the side of the barn that faces the observatory with HEADLIGHTS FACING THE BARN, so they don't shine towards the Observatory.
- No parking on the grass please, reserved only for observatory members setting up their telescopes.
- Nights can be cool, so dress accordingly with a light jacket or sweater.
- Also bring mosquito repellent since some activities will be outside of the telescope dome.
- Subsidized attendance fee is only \$5.25 (plus Eventbrite admin fee of \$1.66).

- The Telescope dome is not heated. Some of the activities will be outside as well.

- Head East on highway #401 for about 25 min. Exit Highway 77 south to Comber/ Leamington.
- You will see a flashing stop sign in Comber. This is #46 Middle Rd. **Don't turn here**, continue straight for one mile to the next intersection at South Middle Rd. and turn right there.
- Observatory is 2 km down on the left side.
