IMPORTANT CHANGES TO PEO'S LICENSE APPLICATION PROCESS

Volunteers are the lifeblood of the PEO. More than 1000 engineers volunteer their time each year to work on behalf of the association. Important changes to PEO's license application processes and Engineering Intern (EIT) program started May 15, 2023:

PEO introduced changes to our license application process that makes applying for an engineering license more efficient, transparent, and fair for all applicants. Starting May 15, 2023, PEO's modernized application process ensures new applicants receive a registration decision within six months of submitting a completed license application.
