If elected, I will actively collaborate with fellow councillors and PEO leadership to advance meaningful progress on the following priorities:

#### Enhance PEAK Reporting

To enhance CPD fairness amongst professional engineers, we should address the discrepancy in PEAK reporting where engineers with similar positions and experience may have varying numbers of CPD hours to be reported

#### CPD hours

I will also advocate for a temporary reduction in the required CPD hours over the next 2–3 years. This adjustment would provide engineers with sufficient time to access meaningful, discipline-specific learning resources.

#### Additional Actions in CPD hours

I will work to explore and establish partnerships with accredited PEAK learning providers to expand accessible, high-quality professional development across all engineering disciplines.

#### EIT [reintroduction]

I will work with fellow councillors and PEO leadership to examine the reintroduction and modernization of the EIT program, with the goal of providing stronger support, guidance, and professional development pathways for newly graduated engineers. Also, motivating new engineer graduates to get their EIT license by promoting its benefits and possibly reducing EIT annual membership fees;

#### Organizational Integration and Coordination

I will also advocate for improved integration, coordination, communication, and implementation across all PEO initiatives to ensure greater consistency, efficiency, and transparency in how we serve the profession.

#### Strengthening the PEO–OSPE Relationship

In addition, I will engage in discussions on enhancing collaboration between PEO and OSPE to build greater synergy, strengthen advocacy efforts, and elevate the visibility and impact of the engineering profession in Ontario.
