MY SEVEN PILLARS:

ENHANCE PEAK REPORTING

Enhancing CPD fairness amongst professional engineers, by addressing discrepancy in PEAK reporting;

CPD HOURS

Will advocate for a temporary reduction in the CPD hours over the next 2 – 3 years. This adjustment will give engineers sufficient time to access discipline-specific resources;

ADDITIONAL ACTIONS IN CPD HOURS

Will work to explore and establish partnerships with accredited PEAK learning providers to expand accessible, and high-quality professional development across all disciplines;

EIT [Reintroduction]

Will work with fellow councillors and PEO leadership to examine the reintroduction and modernization of EIT program, with the goal of providing stronger support, guidance, and professional development pathways for newly graduated engineers. Motivating new engineer graduates to get their EIT license by promoting its benefits;

ORGANIZATIONAL INTEGRATION AND COORDINATION

Will advocate for improved integration, coordination, communication, and implementation across all PEO initiatives to ensure greater consistency, efficiency, and transparency in how we serve PEO members;

STRENGTHENING PEO–OSPE RELATIONSHIP

Will engage in discussions on enhancing collaboration between PEO and OSPE to build greater synergy, strengthen advocacy efforts, and elevate the visibility and impact of the engineering profession in Ontario.

DEVELOPING AI GUIDELINE

Will develop frameworks to ensure AI tools are ethical, transparent, and aligned with PEO values. Steps to be followed include establishing a cross functional working group, listing risks like bias and data privacy, and implementing “human-in-the-loop” oversight for accountability, etc.
